CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

1 WHEREAS, Jean Glaze, a longtime Gilmer resident and civic
2 leader, passed away on January 29, 2011, at the age of 83; and

3 WHEREAS, The former Wilma Jean Franks was born to Samuel
4 Gordon and Maud Augusta Head Franks in Mexia on December 29, 1927;
5 she married Dr. Bob Glaze in Tyler in 1948, and six years later the
6 couple moved to Gilmer; and

7 WHEREAS, Over a span of some five decades, Mrs. Glaze devoted
8 her time and talents to many worthy endeavors and organizations in
9 the Gilmer community; as a board member for Gilmer Main Street on
10 the Square, she helped the town achieve recognition as the Texas
11 Main Street City of the Year in 1999 and designation as a National
12 Main Street City in 2000; among the other groups that gained
13 immeasurably from her membership and support were First Baptist
14 Church, where she worshipped for many years, and the Dahlia Garden
15 Club; and

16 WHEREAS, Mrs. Glaze also encouraged her husband in his
17 important work, which included serving in the Texas House of
18 Representatives from 1991 to 2003; the couple shared a rewarding
19 marriage of 62 years, until Dr. Glaze's death in 2010; and

20 WHEREAS, Jean Glaze touched the hearts of all who were
21 privileged to share in the richness of her life, and she will
22 forever be remembered with deep admiration and affection; now,
23 therefore, be it

24 RESOLVED, That the 82nd Legislature of the State of Texas

1 hereby pay tribute to the life of Jean Glaze and extend sincere
2 sympathy to the members of her family: to her son and
3 daughter-in-law, Dr. Andy Glaze and Sandra Glaze; to her daughters
4 and sons-in-law, Jeannie and Ken Smith and Jill McDaniel and Dr.
5 Randy McDaniel; to her brother and sister-in-law, Paul and Loretta
6 Franks; to her 7 grandchildren and 10 great-grandchildren; and to
7 her other relatives and friends; and, be it further
