CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

- 1 WHEREAS, With the state facing a \$26 billion shortfall, there
- 2 is great risk that unfunded mandates will be placed on local
- 3 governments and that local property tax payers will have to bear the
- 4 brunt of state directives; and
- 5 WHEREAS, Unfunded and underfunded mandates from both the
- 6 state and federal governments impose costs on Texas cities,
- 7 counties, school districts, community college districts, and
- 8 hospital districts, all of which then have no choice but to increase
- 9 local property tax rates or reduce services; and
- 10 WHEREAS, In light of the recent economic recession, which
- 11 continues to affect citizens and local governmental entities alike,
- 12 it is especially critical that the state avoid generating
- 13 additional costs for Texas cities, counties, school districts,
- 14 community college districts, and hospital districts; now,
- 15 therefore, be it
- RESOLVED, That the 82nd Legislature of the State of Texas
- 17 hereby express its intent to avoid placing unfunded mandates,
- 18 including any that may be part of emergency measures, on local
- 19 governments.
