CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

- 1 WHEREAS, Employers include health and retirement benefits in
- 2 their compensation packages as a competitive business practice; and
- 3 WHEREAS, The State of Texas is required by law to provide
- 4 health and retirement benefits through the Employees Retirement
- 5 System of Texas, and these benefits serve to attract and retain
- 6 employees; and
- 7 WHEREAS, Recent state and national events have illustrated
- 8 the economic and political challenges in providing benefit
- 9 programs, but the fact remains that benefits play an important role
- 10 in fostering, promoting, and encouraging state service; now,
- 11 therefore, be it
- 12 RESOLVED, That the 82nd Legislature of the State of Texas
- 13 hereby request the lieutenant governor and the speaker of the house
- 14 of representatives to create a joint interim committee to conduct a
- 15 comprehensive, data-driven study of the benefits, including health
- 16 insurance, retirement programs, and other benefits, of active and
- 17 retired employees of the State of Texas; and, be it further
- 18 RESOLVED, That the study's purview cover the programs
- 19 administered by the Employees Retirement System of Texas; and, be
- 20 it further
- 21 RESOLVED, That the study specifically consider: (1) the
- 22 impact on the state of offering retirement and health benefits; (2)
- 23 the impact on employees of being offered retirement and health
- 24 benefits; (3) the impact of retiree health benefits in calculating

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- 1 Other Post-Employment Benefit (OPEB) liabilities; and, be it
- 2 further
- 3 RESOLVED, That the study specifically address the
- 4 feasibility of the current defined benefit plan, as well as the
- 5 feasibility of creating a defined contribution or hybrid plan,
- 6 placing each option within the context of (1) providing a proper
- 7 system for managing risk; (2) encouraging employee behavior that
- 8 best meets the workforce needs of the State of Texas; (3) funding
- 9 benefits in a sound manner; and (4) providing adequate retirement
- 10 income at a reasonable retirement age after a reasonable period of
- 11 employment; and, be it further
- 12 RESOLVED, That the committee submit not later than March 1,
- 13 2012, a full report, including findings and recommendations, to the
- 14 lieutenant governor, the speaker of the house of representatives,
- 15 and the governor.
