

HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

1 WHEREAS, Cameron Blizzard of Clear Lake has prevailed in his
2 battle against cancer, and his courage and determination inspired
3 countless people along the way; and

4 WHEREAS, A junior at Clear Lake High School, Mr. Blizzard was
5 diagnosed with Hodgkin's Lymphoma on October 7, 2010, and three
6 months later in January 2011, following chemotherapy and radiation
7 treatment, he was given a clean bill of health by his oncologist at
8 Texas Children's Cancer Center; and

9 WHEREAS, Mr. Blizzard's peers rallied behind him, organizing
10 numerous fund-raisers in his behalf; the CLHS student council
11 designated a Team Cameron Day and sold more than 250 Team Cameron
12 shirts with proceeds going to the Texas Children's Cancer Center,
13 which also benefited from several student car washes; Mr.
14 Blizzard's golf teammates were especially moved to act, and the
15 boys' and girls' golf teams donated money from the sale of more than
16 600 Lymphoma bracelets to the Lymphoma Society; moreover, each team
17 designated events in his honor; and

18 WHEREAS, A variety of other endeavors also took place in a
19 show of concern and encouragement for Mr. Blizzard; the Flairs
20 Dance Team made a blanket for him that was signed by the student
21 body, and CLHS athletic coaches ordered and wore Team Cameron golf
22 shirts; Mr. Blizzard was further aided by Assisteens of the Bay
23 Area, local churches, the Texas A&M golf team, and the Florida State
24 University football team, and a website to help organize offers of

1 assistance was set up by friends in the community; and

2 WHEREAS, Cameron Blizzard has surmounted a major life
3 challenge, and his cancer-free status is indeed cause for
4 celebration; now, therefore, be it

5 RESOLVED, That the 82nd Legislature of the State of Texas
6 hereby congratulate Cameron Blizzard on overcoming cancer and
7 extend to him sincere best wishes for the future; and, be it further

8 RESOLVED, That an official copy of this resolution be
9 prepared for Mr. Blizzard as an expression of high regard by the
10 Texas House of Representatives and Senate.
