## A JOINT RESOLUTION

1 proposing a constitutional amendment authorizing the legislature

- 2 to permit certain political subdivisions in Harris County to
- 3 establish a limit on the maximum appraised value of residence
- 4 homesteads for ad valorem taxation by those political subdivisions
- 5 of 105 percent of the appraised value of the property for the
- 6 preceding tax year.
- 7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 8 SECTION 1. Section 1, Article VIII, Texas Constitution, is
- 9 amended by adding Subsection (k) to read as follows:
- 10 (k) Notwithstanding Subsections (a), (b), and (i) of this
- 11 section, the Legislature by general law may authorize the governing
- 12 body of a political subdivision other than a school district but
- 13 including a junior college district, a majority of the territory of
- 14 which is located in Harris County, to establish for purposes of ad
- 15 valorem taxation by the political subdivision a limit on the
- 16 maximum appraised value of a residence homestead in the political
- 17 subdivision of 105 percent of the appraised value of the property
- 18 for the preceding tax year. A limit on maximum appraised value
- 19 established under this subsection takes effect as to a residence
- 20 homestead on the later of January 1 of the tax year following the
- 21 year in which the limit is established or January 1 of the tax year
- 22 following the first tax year the owner qualifies the property for an
- 23 <u>exemption under Section 1-b of this article.</u> As to a residence
- 24 homestead, the limit expires on January 1 of the first tax year that

- 1 neither the owner of the property when the limit took effect nor the
- 2 owner's spouse or surviving spouse qualifies for an exemption under
- 3 Section 1-b of this article. If the governing body of a political
- 4 subdivision establishes a limit on maximum appraised value under
- 5 this subsection, the limit remains in effect until repealed or
- 6 rescinded by the governing body of the political subdivision.
- 7 SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
- 8 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 8, 2011.
- 9 The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the
- 10 proposition: "The constitutional amendment authorizing the
- 11 legislature to permit certain political subdivisions in Harris
- 12 County to establish a limit on the maximum appraised value of
- 13 residence homesteads for ad valorem taxation by those political
- 14 subdivisions of 105 percent of the appraised value of the property
- 15 for the preceding tax year."
