A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 proposing a constitutional amendment to prohibit the state or a
- 2 governmental entity in the state from providing support for the
- 3 performance of an abortion or abortion-related services.
- 4 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Article III, Texas Constitution, is amended by
- 6 adding Section 521 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 521. This state or a governmental entity in this state
- 8 may not provide support to a person or facility that performs
- 9 abortions or provides abortion-related services. Support
- 10 <u>includes:</u>
- 11 (1) directly or indirectly using state or local tax
- 12 revenue to finance the performance of an abortion or a service
- 13 <u>related to an abortion; and</u>
- 14 (2) providing preferential access to assets that are
- 15 owned or controlled by this state or a governmental entity in this
- 16 state through a lease, contract, or other agreement.
- 17 SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
- 18 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 8, 2011.
- 19 The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the
- 20 proposition: "The constitutional amendment to prohibit the state
- 21 or a governmental entity in the state from providing support for the
- 22 performance of an abortion or abortion-related services."
