## A JOINT RESOLUTION

proposing a constitutional amendment authorizing the legislature 1 2 to exempt from ad valorem taxation the residence homestead of the surviving spouse of a 100 percent or totally disabled veteran in an 3 amount equal to the amount of the residence homestead exemption to 4 5 which the disabled veteran was entitled on the same property.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 6 7 SECTION 1. Section 1-b, Article VIII, Texas Constitution, is amended by adding Subsection (j) to read as follows:

9 (j) The legislature by general law may provide that the surviving spouse of a 100 percent or totally disabled veteran who 10 received an exemption in accordance with Subsection (i) of this 11 section is entitled to an exemption for the same property in an 12 amount equal to the amount of the exemption received by the disabled 13 14 veteran if:

(1) the surviving spouse has not remarried since the 15 16 death of the disabled veteran; and

17 (2) the property:

18 was the residence homestead of the surviving (A) spouse when the disabled veteran died; and 19 (B) remains the residence homestead of 20 the

21 surviving spouse.

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The following temporary provision is added to 22 SECTION 2. 23 the Texas Constitution:

TEMPORARY PROVISION. (a) \_\_\_\_\_\_ This temporary provision applies 24

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to the constitutional amendment proposed by the 82nd Legislature, 1 Regular Session, 2011, authorizing the legislature to exempt from 2 ad valorem taxation the residence homestead of the surviving spouse 3 of a 100 percent or totally disabled veteran in an amount equal to 4 the amount of the residence homestead exemption to which the 5 6 disabled veteran was entitled. (b) Section 1-b(j), Article VIII, of this constitution 7 takes effect January 1, 2012, and applies only to a tax year 8

- 9 beginning on or after that date.
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## (c) This temporary provision expires January 1, 2013.

SECTION 3.
