## A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 proposing a constitutional amendment authorizing the legislature
- 2 to exempt from ad valorem taxation the residence homestead of the
- 3 surviving spouse of a 100 percent or totally disabled veteran in an
- 4 amount equal to the amount of the residence homestead exemption to
- 5 which the disabled veteran was entitled on the same property.
- 6 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 7 SECTION 1. Section 1-b, Article VIII, Texas Constitution,
- 8 is amended by adding Subsection (j) to read as follows:
- 9 (j) The legislature by general law may provide that the
- 10 <u>surviving spouse of a 100 percent or totally disabled veteran who</u>
- 11 received an exemption in accordance with Subsection (i) of this
- 12 <u>section</u> is entitled to an exemption for the same property in an
- 13 <u>amount equal to the amount of the exemption received by the disabled</u>
- 14 veteran if:
- 15 (1) the surviving spouse has not remarried since the
- 16 death of the disabled veteran; and
- 17 (2) the property:
- (A) was the residence homestead of the surviving
- 19 spouse when the disabled veteran died; and
- 20 (B) remains the residence homestead of the
- 21 <u>surviving spouse.</u>
- 22 SECTION 2. The following temporary provision is added to
- 23 the Texas Constitution:
- TEMPORARY PROVISION. (a) This temporary provision applies

- 1 to the constitutional amendment proposed by the 82nd Legislature,
- 2 Regular Session, 2011, authorizing the legislature to exempt from
- 3 ad valorem taxation the residence homestead of the surviving spouse
- 4 of a 100 percent or totally disabled veteran in an amount equal to
- 5 the amount of the residence homestead exemption to which the
- 6 <u>disabled veteran was entitled.</u>
- 7 (b) Section 1-b(j), Article VIII, of this constitution
- 8 takes effect January 1, 2012, and applies only to a tax year
- 9 beginning on or after that date.
- 10 (c) This temporary provision expires January 1, 2013.
- 11 SECTION 3. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
- 12 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 8, 2011.
- 13 The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the
- 14 proposition: "The constitutional amendment authorizing the
- 15 legislature to exempt from ad valorem taxation the residence
- 16 homestead of the surviving spouse of a 100 percent or totally
- 17 disabled veteran in an amount equal to the amount of the residence
- 18 homestead exemption to which the disabled veteran was entitled on
- 19 the same property."
