## A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 proposing a constitutional amendment to restrict the power of the
- 2 legislature to mandate requirements upon certain local
- 3 governments.
- 4 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Article III of the Texas Constitution is amended
- 6 by adding Section 68 as follows:
- 7 Sec. 68. (a) No bill enacted by the legislature on or after
- 8 January 1, 2012 requiring a local government to establish, expand,
- 9 or modify a duty or activity that requires the expenditure of
- 10 revenue by the local government shall be effective until and unless
- 11 the legislature appropriates or otherwise provides for the payment
- 12 or reimbursement, from a source other than the revenue of the local
- 13 government, or the costs incurred for the biennium by the local
- 14 government in complying with the requirement.
- 15 (b) For the purpose of this section, "local government"
- 16 includes a county, a city, a hospital district, a community college
- 17 district, or a special district created by the action of a county,
- 18 city, hospital district, or community college.
- 19 SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
- 20 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 8, 2011.
- 21 The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the
- 22 proposition: "The constitutional amendment to restrict the power
- 23 of the legislature from mandating unfunded requirements upon local
- 24 governments."
