A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 applying to the Congress of the United States to call a convention
- 2 to propose an amendment to the United States Constitution to
- 3 require a balanced federal budget.
- 4 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 WHEREAS, The United States Constitution contains no
- 6 restriction on the power of the federal government to incur a budget
- 7 deficit; and
- 8 WHEREAS, Article V of the United States Constitution provides
- 9 that on application of the legislatures of two-thirds of the
- 10 several states Congress shall call a convention for proposing
- 11 amendments to the constitution; now, therefore, be it
- 12 RESOLVED, That the 82nd Texas Legislature apply to Congress
- 13 to call a convention under Article V of the United States
- 14 Constitution for the exclusive purpose of proposing an amendment to
- 15 the constitution providing that except in time of war or other
- 16 national emergency the total of all federal appropriations for a
- 17 fiscal year may not exceed the total of all estimated federal
- 18 revenue for that fiscal year; and, be it further
- 19 RESOLVED, That, unless rescinded by a succeeding
- 20 legislature, this application by the 82nd Texas Legislature
- 21 constitutes a continuing application in accordance with Article V
- 22 of the United States Constitution until at least two-thirds of the
- 23 legislatures of the several states have applied to Congress to call
- 24 a convention to propose an amendment to the constitution to provide

- 1 for a balanced federal budget, but if Congress proposes a
- 2 constitutional amendment identical in subject matter to that
- 3 contained in this resolution, this application is no longer of any
- 4 force; and, be it further
- 5 RESOLVED, That this application is rescinded in the event
- 6 that a convention to propose amendments to the United States
- 7 Constitution includes purposes other than providing for a balanced
- 8 federal budget; and, be it further
- 9 RESOLVED, That the Texas secretary of state forward official
- 10 copies of this resolution to the president of the United States, to
- 11 the speaker of the House of Representatives and the president of the
- 12 Senate of the Congress of the United States, and to all members of
- 13 the Texas delegation to Congress with the request that this
- 14 resolution be officially entered in the Congressional Record as an
- 15 application to Congress for a convention to propose an amendment to
- 16 the United States Constitution to provide for a balanced federal
- 17 budget; and, be it further
- RESOLVED, That the Texas secretary of state forward official
- 19 copies of this resolution to the secretaries of state and to the
- 20 presiding officers of the legislatures of the several states with
- 21 the request that they join this state in applying to Congress for a
- 22 convention to propose an amendment to the United States
- 23 Constitution to provide for a balanced federal budget.
