A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 proposing a constitutional amendment authorizing the legislature
- 2 to exempt from ad valorem taxation by a school district for
- 3 maintenance and operations purposes all or part of the appraised
- 4 value of a residence homestead.
- 5 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 1-b, Article VIII, Texas Constitution,
- 7 is amended by adding Subsections (d-2) and (j) to read as follows:
- 8 (d-2) Notwithstanding Subsections (d) and (d-1) of this
- 9 section, a general law enacted under Subsection (j) of this section
- 10 may provide for the reduction of the amount of a limitation provided
- 11 by Subsection (d) of this section as reduced under Subsection (d-1)
- 12 of this section, if applicable, and applicable to a residence
- 13 homestead for the tax year in which the general law takes effect to
- 14 reflect any reduction from the preceding year in the tax rate for
- 15 general elementary and secondary public school purposes applicable
- 16 to the homestead. A general law enacted under Subsection (j) of
- 17 this section may provide that, except as otherwise provided by
- 18 <u>Subsection (d) of this section, a limitation provided by Subsection</u>
- 19 (d) of this section as reduced under Subsection (d-1) of this
- 20 section, if applicable, that is reduced under the general law
- 21 continues to apply to the residence homestead in subsequent tax
- 22 years until the limitation expires.
- 23 <u>(j) The legislature by general law may exempt from ad</u>
- 24 valorem taxation by a school district for maintenance and

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- 1 operations purposes all or part of the appraised value of the
- 2 residence homestead of a married or unmarried adult, including one
- 3 living alone.
- 4 SECTION 2. The following temporary provision is added to
- 5 the Texas Constitution:
- 6 TEMPORARY PROVISION. (a) This temporary provision applies
- 7 to the constitutional amendment proposed by the 82nd Legislature,
- 8 Regular Session, 2011, authorizing the legislature to exempt from
- 9 ad valorem taxation by a school district for maintenance and
- 10 operations purposes all or part of the appraised value of a
- 11 residence homestead.
- 12 (b) Section 1-b(j), Article VIII, of this constitution
- 13 takes effect January 1, 2012, and applies only to a tax year
- 14 beginning on or after that date.
- 15 (c) This temporary provision expires January 1, 2013.
- 16 SECTION 3. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
- 17 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 8, 2011.
- 18 The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the
- 19 proposition: "The constitutional amendment authorizing the
- 20 legislature to exempt from ad valorem taxation by a school district
- 21 for maintenance and operations purposes all or part of the
- 22 appraised value of a residence homestead."
