A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 proposing a constitutional amendment authorizing garnishment of
- 2 wages for the recovery of fraudulently obtained unemployment
- 3 benefits.
- 4 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 28, Article XVI, Texas Constitution, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 28. No current wages for personal service shall ever be
- 8 subject to garnishment, except for:
- 9 (1) the enforcement of court-ordered:
- (A) $\left[\frac{1}{1}\right]$ child support payments; or
- (B) $\left[\frac{(2)}{2}\right]$ spousal maintenance; or
- 12 (2) the recovery of fraudulently obtained
- 13 <u>unemployment benefits</u>.
- 14 SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
- 15 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 8, 2011.
- 16 The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the
- 17 proposition: "The constitutional amendment authorizing
- 18 garnishment of wages for the recovery of fraudulently obtained
- 19 unemployment benefits."
