## A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 proposing a constitutional amendment authorizing the legislature
- 2 to provide for a temporary exemption from ad valorem taxation of the
- 3 residence homestead of the surviving spouse of a firefighter or
- 4 peace officer killed while performing official duties.
- 5 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 1-b, Article VIII, Texas Constitution,
- 7 is amended by adding Subsection (k) to read as follows:
- 8 (k) The legislature by general law may provide that the
- 9 surviving spouse of a firefighter or peace officer killed while
- 10 performing official duties is entitled to a five-year exemption
- 11 from ad valorem taxation of a residence homestead that is the
- 12 principal residence of the surviving spouse. The legislature by
- 13 general law shall define the terms "firefighter" and "peace
- 14 officer" for purposes of this subsection. The legislature by
- 15 general law may provide additional limitations on the eligibility
- 16 for and use of an exemption under this subsection.
- 17 SECTION 2. The following temporary provision is added to
- 18 the Texas Constitution:
- 19 <u>TEMPORARY PROVISION.</u> (a) This temporary provision applies
- 20 to the constitutional amendment proposed by the 82nd Legislature,
- 21 Regular Session, 2011, authorizing the legislature to provide for a
- 22 temporary exemption from ad valorem taxation of the residence
- 23 homestead of the surviving spouse of a firefighter or peace officer
- 24 killed while performing official duties.

- 1 (b) Section 1-b(k), Article VIII, of this constitution
- 2 takes effect January 1, 2012, and applies only to a tax year
- 3 beginning on or after that date.
- 4 (c) This temporary provision expires January 1, 2013.
- 5 SECTION 3. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
- 6 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 8, 2011.
- 7 The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the
- 8 proposition: "The constitutional amendment authorizing the
- 9 legislature to provide for a temporary exemption from ad valorem
- 10 taxation of the residence homestead of the surviving spouse of a
- 11 firefighter or peace officer killed while performing official
- 12 duties."
