## A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 proposing a constitutional amendment requiring a state senator or
- 2 state representative to forfeit office on the final conviction of a
- 3 felony.
- 4 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Article III, Texas Constitution, is amended by
- 6 adding Section 11-a to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 11-a. If any Senator or Representative is finally
- 8 convicted of a felony under the law of this state, another state, or
- 9 the United States, the Senator or Representative shall immediately
- 10 forfeit the Senator's or Representative's office, and the vacancy
- 11 shall be filled as provided by Section 13 of this article. A person
- 12 who forfeits office under this section may not continue to perform
- 13 the duties of the office under Section 17, Article XVI, of this
- 14 constitution.
- 15 SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
- 16 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 8, 2011.
- 17 The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the
- 18 proposition: "The constitutional amendment requiring a state
- 19 senator or state representative to immediately forfeit legislative
- 20 office on final conviction of a felony."
