A JOINT RESOLUTION

1 proposing a constitutional amendment providing for the creation and

- 2 funding of the state water implementation fund for Texas to assist
- 3 the Texas Water Development Board in the funding of certain
- 4 projects included in the state water plan.
- 5 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Article III, Texas Constitution, is amended by
- 7 adding Section 49-d-12 to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 49-d-12. (a) The state water implementation fund for
- 9 Texas is created in the state treasury to provide a method for
- 10 financing projects included in a statewide water plan that is
- 11 required by general law and adopted by the Texas Water Development
- 12 Board or its successor in function.
- 13 (b) Money deposited to the credit of the state water
- 14 implementation fund for Texas and interest earned on the investment
- 15 of money credited to the fund shall be administered, without
- 16 further appropriation, by the Texas Water Development Board or its
- 17 successor in function and used only to fund projects included in a
- 18 statewide water plan that is required by general law and adopted by
- 19 the Texas Water Development Board or its successor in function.
- 20 <u>(c) The legislature by general law:</u>
- 21 (1) may provide for the imposition by this state of a
- 22 fee or tax the proceeds of which shall be deposited to the credit of
- 23 the state water implementation fund for Texas and may provide for
- 24 the deposit of other sources of revenue to the credit of the fund;

- 2 (2) shall prescribe the manner in which money in the
- 3 fund may be used.
- 4 (d) This subsection expires September 1, 2027. The
- 5 legislature by general law shall provide for the imposition of a
- 6 public water supply service connection fee to be collected by a
- 7 water utility from the utility's customers. The legislature by
- 8 general law may provide for exemptions from the fee. A fee
- 9 collected under this subsection shall be deposited to the credit of
- 10 the state water implementation fund for Texas. The comptroller of
- 11 public accounts by rule shall establish the rate of the fee, which
- 12 may not exceed:
- 13 (1) \$1 each month, if the connection is for a
- 14 residential use;
- 15 (2) \$5 each month, if the connection is for a
- 16 <u>commercial use; or</u>
- 17 (3) \$100 each month, if the connection is for an
- 18 industrial use.
- 19 (e) A general law enacted under this section dedicating
- 20 revenue to the state water implementation fund for Texas prevails
- 21 over any Act enacted in the same session of the legislature that
- 22 purports to abolish dedications of revenue in the state treasury
- 23 for a particular purpose, regardless of the relative dates of
- 24 enactment.
- 25 (f) If the system benefit fund created under Section 39.903,
- 26 Utilities Code, or its successor in function exists on September 1,
- 27 2014, the comptroller of public accounts shall transfer from that

- 1 fund or its successor in function the lesser of \$500 million or the
- 2 amount available in that fund or its successor in function to the
- 3 state water implementation fund for Texas on that date. This
- 4 subsection expires September 1, 2015.
- 5 SECTION 2. The following temporary provision is added to
- 6 the Texas Constitution:
- 7 TEMPORARY PROVISION. (a) This temporary provision applies to
- 8 the constitutional amendment proposed by the 82nd Legislature,
- 9 Regular Session, 2011, providing for the creation and funding of
- 10 the state water implementation fund for Texas to assist the Texas
- 11 Water Development Board in the funding of certain projects included
- 12 in the state water plan.
- 13 (b) A general law enacted in anticipation of the adoption of
- 14 the amendment is not void due to the law's anticipatory character.
- 15 (c) This temporary provision expires January 1, 2013.
- 16 SECTION 3. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
- 17 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 8, 2011.
- 18 The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the
- 19 proposition: "The constitutional amendment providing for the
- 20 creation and funding of the state water implementation fund for
- 21 Texas to assist the Texas Water Development Board in the funding of
- 22 certain projects included in the state water plan."
