A JOINT RESOLUTION

1 proposing a constitutional amendment authorizing the legislature  
2 to provide for a four-year term for the chief appraiser of an  
3 appraisal district.

4 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 30, Article XVI, Texas Constitution, is  
6 amended by adding Subsection (e) to read as follows:

7 (e) The Legislature by general law may provide that the  
8 chief appraiser of an appraisal district serves a term not to exceed  
9 four years.

10 SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be  
11 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 8, 2011.  
12 The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the  
13 proposition: "The constitutional amendment authorizing the  
14 legislature to provide for a four-year term for the chief appraiser  
15 of an appraisal district."
