## A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 proposing a constitutional amendment authorizing the legislature
- 2 to provide for a four-year term for the chief appraiser of an
- 3 appraisal district.
- 4 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 30, Article XVI, Texas Constitution, is
- 6 amended by adding Subsection (e) to read as follows:
- 7 (e) The Legislature by general law may provide that the
- 8 chief appraiser of an appraisal district serves a term not to exceed
- 9 four years.
- 10 SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
- 11 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 8, 2011.
- 12 The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the
- 13 proposition: "The constitutional amendment authorizing the
- 14 legislature to provide for a four-year term for the chief appraiser
- 15 of an appraisal district."
