

R E S O L U T I O N

1           WHEREAS, Clarence R. Williams is retiring as president and  
2 chief executive officer of the San Antonio Area Foundation on  
3 December 31, 2011, drawing to a close more than a decade of  
4 outstanding service to the community; and

5           WHEREAS, Over the course of his tenure, "Reggie" Williams has  
6 skillfully guided the foundation in fulfilling its mission to help  
7 donors in South Central Texas achieve their philanthropic goals by  
8 building partnerships with nonprofit organizations; under his  
9 leadership, the foundation has established scholarships,  
10 instituted environmental education programs, and provided support  
11 to wounded veterans and senior citizens; and

12           WHEREAS, After earning a master's degree in education, Mr.  
13 Williams was commissioned as an officer in the U.S. Air Force, and  
14 he is a graduate of the National Defense University's Armed Forces  
15 Staff College and the Industrial College of the Armed Forces; he  
16 retired from the air force at the rank of colonel and went on to work  
17 as senior vice president of information systems operations at USAA  
18 insurance company; and

19           WHEREAS, Mr. Williams has served his community as board  
20 president of the Rotary Club of San Antonio, chair of the advisory  
21 board of the San Antonio United Negro College Fund, and executive  
22 chair of the USAA Volunteer Corp; he has also been an advisor to the  
23 board of Ella Austin Community Center and a member of the boards of  
24 Los Compadres de San Antonio Missions, CHRISTUS Santa Rosa, the

1 College of Wooster, and the United Way of San Antonio and Bexar  
2 County, among others; and

3 WHEREAS, For many years, Reggie Williams has been an  
4 inspiring mentor and civic leader in San Antonio, earning the  
5 respect and admiration of countless individuals, and his  
6 dedication, professionalism, and deep compassion have greatly  
7 benefited the community; now, therefore, be it

8 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 82nd Texas  
9 Legislature hereby commend Clarence R. Williams on his exemplary  
10 service as president and CEO of the San Antonio Area Foundation and  
11 extend to him sincere best wishes for continued success; and, be it
