1 WHEREAS, In an outstanding display of skill and
2 determination, the Hawks volleyball team of Hebron High School in
3 Carrollton captured the University Interscholastic League 5A state
4 championship on November 20, 2010; and

5 WHEREAS, Hebron's victory in the championship came against a
6 talented team from The Woodlands High School and brought a
7 triumphant end to a spectacular season in which the Hawks notched 44
8 wins and just 7 losses; and

9 WHEREAS, The championship triumph featured a dramatic
10 comeback in the third set, in which the Hawks scored seven
11 unanswered points after being down 24-17 and went on to win 27-25;
12 Tiffany Baker was named the championship game most valuable player,
13 and she and teammates Rachel Buckley and Brittany Sample were named
14 to the all-tournament team; and

15 WHEREAS, Ms. Baker has also been honored as the 2010-2011
16 Gatorade Texas Volleyball Player of the Year and is one of only 25
17 young women from around the country named as an Under Armour Girls
18 High School First Team All-American; and

19 WHEREAS, The Hawks also received vital contributions from the
20 other members of the team: Andie Barron, Cara Crenshaw, Heather
21 Bailey, Morgan Allred, Kate King, Olivia Okoro, Micaela Spann,
22 Sarah Anderson, Taylor Patterson, Jenna Allen, Kayley Walker, and
23 Taylor Cembalisty; these talented athletes were led to the
24 championship by head coach Karin Keeney; and

1 WHEREAS, Winning a state championship represents the
2 culmination of countless hours of hard work and an unwavering
3 commitment to teamwork, and the members of the Hebron Hawks
4 volleyball team may indeed reflect with pride on a job well done;
5 now, therefore, be it

7 Legislature hereby congratulate the Hebron Hawks volleyball team on
8 winning the UIL 5A state championship for 2010 and extend to the
