- 6 to sleep simply because homes are not found for them and resources
- 7 and space at shelters are limited, especially in these challenging
- 8 economic times; and
- 9 WHEREAS, Shelters offer low-cost adoptions, allowing
- 10 aspiring pet owners to affordably befriend a new animal companion;
- 11 moreover, pets from shelters are generally spayed or neutered at
- 12 the time of adoption, which helps reduce future numbers of unwanted
- 13 animals; and
- 14 WHEREAS, Providing a home for a pet has been shown to promote
- 15 a healthy lifestyle for owners by providing opportunities for
- 16 exercise and social interaction with other pet owners; studies also
- 17 indicate that children who help care for pets have higher
- 18 self-esteem and enhanced social skills; and
- 19 WHEREAS, Adopting pets from local animal shelters helps
- 20 reduce the burdens placed on these vital community resources and
- 21 makes a profound difference in the lives of animals in need as well
- 22 as in the lives of the people who take them into their hearts and
- 23 homes; now, therefore, be it
