## RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, The thriving membership of these organizations 9 demonstrates the large number of Texas citizens who are avid 10 11 bikers; hundreds of thousands of motorcycles are registered in the Lone Star State, and this biennial legislative rally draws 12 thousands of motorcyclists to Austin; the advocacy of dedicated 13 14 riders has contributed to numerous positive developments through the years, including the "Share the Road" initiative, and they have 15 16 also backed other programs that promote the safety of Texans on two wheels, including the "Look Twice for Motorcycles" campaign 17 sponsored by the Texas Transportation Institute; and 18
