Infantry Division, Lieutenant Andrews was based at Fort Richardson,
Alaska; he was killed in action while bravely serving his country
during his second tour of duty in Afghanistan; and

9 WHEREAS, Darryn Andrews was born to Robert and Sondra Andrews in Ogden, Utah; he attended C. H. Yoe High School in Cameron, where 10 11 he played baseball, football, and basketball and was active in 12 drama and the student council; with scholarships from the Veterans of Foreign Wars and the Athletic Booster Club, he earned a 13 14 bachelor's degree in business from Texas Tech University, and he went on to receive a master's degree in education administration 15 16 from Texas State University; and

WHEREAS, Since childhood, Mr. Andrews had been inspired by his grandfather's service in World War II, and after the attacks of 9/11, he surprised no one when he answered his nation's call to duty and enlisted in the army; a proud soldier, he planned to dedicate his life to the military; and

22 WHEREAS, Lieutenant Andrews married the former Julie Smith on 23 February 26, 2007; the couple were blessed with a son, Daylan Deen, 24 and Mrs. Andrews was pregnant with their second child at the time of
