- 1 WHEREAS, Representatives of the East End Chamber of Commerce
- 2 in Houston are visiting the State Capitol on January 25, 2011, and
- 3 the occasion provides an opportunity to recognize this culturally
- 4 significant and economically dynamic community; and
- 5 WHEREAS, The history of the East End began a decade before the
- 6 founding of Houston itself, when the town of Harrisburg was
- 7 surveyed in 1826; it served both as a shipping center for early
- 8 Texas colonies and briefly as the capital of the Republic of Texas
- 9 in 1836; though the Mexican Army burned down all but one house in
- 10 the town later that year, it was quickly rebuilt and in the
- 11 mid-1800s became the site of the first railroad terminal in the
- 12 state; Houston annexed Harrisburg in 1926; and
- WHEREAS, Today, the East End is the proud home of the Port of
- 14 Houston, one of the nation's foremost ports for international trade
- 15 and one of the largest port facilities in the world; and
- 16 WHEREAS, The Strategic Vision for the East End, completed in
- 17 2006 by the East End Chamber of Commerce and its partner
- 18 organizations and stakeholders, recognized six priorities:
- 19 economic development, educational resources, history, image,
- 20 infrastructure, and parks and neighborhoods; and
- 21 WHEREAS, Guided by these priorities, the chamber of commerce
- 22 and its partners have already made remarkable progress;
- 23 accomplishments include the initiation of a National Engineering
- 24 Academy at Chavez High School, the creation of two Port of Houston

- 1 Maritime Academies, which opened at Stephen F. Austin and Jack
- 2 Yates High Schools in August 2009, and the establishment of an
- 3 Economic Development Division to nurture current ventures and draw
- 4 new investment to the area; and

- 6 Chamber of Commerce have helped make this proud Texas community an
- 7 even better place to live and work, and the chamber merits special
- 8 commendation for its achievements; now, therefore, be it
