1 WHEREAS, The family and friends of United States Army Private
2 First Class Austin Garrett Staggs suffered an immeasurable loss
3 with the death of this valiant soldier on November 29, 2010, at the
4 age of 19; and

5 WHEREAS, Assigned to the 1st Squadron, 61st Cavalry Regiment,
6 4th Brigade Combat Team, 101st Airborne Division, Private Staggs
7 lost his life while bravely serving in Afghanistan; and

8 WHEREAS, Born in Fort Worth to Kaye Jordan and Byram Staggs,
9 Austin Staggs came of age in Weatherford, graduating from North
10 Hills Private School in nearby Millsap; in his youth, he was active
11 in the Boy Scouts and Young Marines, and he subsequently fulfilled a
12 desire to serve his country when he joined the U.S. Army; and

13 WHEREAS, Private Staggs was a beloved husband to Sheena
14 Staggs and father to his son, Kallen; an avid outdoorsman, he
15 enjoyed hunting, fishing, and horses, as well as music and games;
16 after his military service, he hoped to return to Texas and pursue a
17 career in police work; and

18 WHEREAS, Americans owe a profound debt to our nation's
19 servicemen and servicewomen, whose courageous efforts and enormous
20 sacrifices are deserving of their fellow citizens' deepest respect
21 and gratitude, and although the passing of Austin Staggs has left a
22 void in the lives of those who were fortunate enough to know him,
23 they will forever carry his memory close in their hearts; now,
24 therefore, be it

1 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 82nd Texas
2 Legislature hereby pay tribute to the life of U.S. Army Private
3 First Class Austin Garrett Staggs and extend deepest sympathy to
4 the members of his family: to his wife, Sheena Staggs; to his son,
5 Kallen Garrett O'Neal; to his mother and stepfather, Kaye and Judd
6 Jordan; to his father, Byram Staggs; to his half-siblings, Emily,
7 B. J., and Sarah Staggs; to his stepbrothers, Judson and Jacob
