19 Bielss coached and officiated a variety of sports, and he was an
20 avid reader and traveler; this esteemed Texan was also a Master
21 Mason and a member of Shriners International, and he served as a

23 WHEREAS, Otto Bielss, Jr., brightened the lives of all those
24 who were fortunate enough to know him, and he will be fondly
