1 WHEREAS, A life made rich through meaningful service drew to
2 a close when Floyd A. Mechler, Jr., of Spring passed away on
3 November 30, 2010, at the age of 60; and

4 WHEREAS, Born in San Antonio on February 15, 1950,
5 Mr. Mechler had a long history of involvement in the water
6 industry, and he was committed to promoting the wise use of this
7 precious resource; a former director and president of the Cypress
8 Forest Public Utility District and a longtime member of the
9 Association of Water Board Directors--Texas, he served on the AWBD
10 Board of Trustees from 1986 to 1994 and led the board as president
11 in 1988, 1989, and 1990; he was also active on the AWBD Water Smart
12 Steering Committee, which guides the association's water
13 conservation public awareness campaign; in 2007 he received the
14 AWBD Visions Award, the association's highest honor; and

15 WHEREAS, Mr. Mechler's outstanding civic contributions
16 included service on the Klein Independent School District Board of
17 Trustees and on the Klein Education Foundation Board of Directors;
18 he was also a valued congregant of Saint Dunstan's Episcopal
19 Church; and

20 WHEREAS, In all of his endeavors, Mr. Mechler enjoyed the
21 love and support of his two children, Russell and Michelle, and his
22 three grandchildren; and

23 WHEREAS, While the death of Floyd Mechler has brought great
24 sorrow to his family and friends, he has left behind a legacy that

1 will long be treasured by all those who held him dear; now,
2 therefore, be it

3 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 82nd Texas
4 Legislature hereby pay tribute to the life of Floyd A. Mechler, Jr.,
5 and extend sincere condolences to the members of his family: to his
6 son, Russell Mechler, and his wife, Danielle; to his daughter,
