2 community are gathering at the State Capitol on February 1, 2011, to  
3 celebrate the school's vital role in the Lone Star State; and

4           WHEREAS, Chartered in 1845 by the Republic of Texas through  
5 the efforts of Baptist pioneers, Baylor University is the oldest  
6 continually operating university in the state; originally located  
7 in Independence, it was later moved to Waco, where the campus  
8 currently encompasses 735 acres; through the years, the school has  
9 adapted to meet the ever-changing needs of those it serves, while  
10 continuing to fulfill its original mission and honor its heritage  
11 as a Christian university; and

12           WHEREAS, This nationally ranked liberal arts institution  
13 offers 151 areas of study, pre-professional tracks, and specialized  
14 academic opportunities catering to a student body of more than  
15 14,000; through its faculty's commitment to teaching, scholarship,  
16 and interdisciplinary research, Baylor has earned an international  
17 reputation for educational excellence, and the school's  
18 outstanding alumni range from heads of Fortune 500 companies to  
19 religious leaders to governors of Texas; and

20           WHEREAS, Baylor University has provided generations of  
21 students with an exceptional education and a strong, principled  
22 foundation, and in so doing, it is contributing immeasurably to the  
23 future of the Lone Star State; now, therefore, be it
