- 17 a number of leadership positions during his 21 years with the guard,
- 18 including commander of the Joint Task Force Safe Border and deputy
- 19 assistant adjutant general; in 2005 he joined the Texas State Guard
- 20 and assumed command of the 1st Regiment; a year later, in October
- 21 2006, he was promoted to his present rank and named deputy
- 22 commanding general--army; and
- WHEREAS, This esteemed officer is a graduate of the U.S. Army
- 24 Field Artillery School, the U.S. Army Command and General Staff

- 1 College, and the U.S. Army War College; he has also earned a master
- 2 of arts in education from The University of Texas at San Antonio;

- 13 General Ortiz has demonstrated a consummate professionalism and an
