R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, Members of the Texas Aggregates and Concrete
2 Association are gathering in Austin for their legislative day at
3 the State Capitol on February 9, 2011; and

4 WHEREAS, The Texas Aggregates and Concrete Association was
5 created in 1974 when the Texas Ready Mixed Concrete Association and
6 the Texas Aggregates Association were united; and

7 WHEREAS, In the years since, TACA has grown to more than 200
8 member companies throughout Texas, including 75 percent of the
9 state's concrete business owners, 100 percent of the cement
10 companies, and 80 percent of the aggregates firms; and

13 thousands of Texans; as part of its mission, TACA advocates for
14 sustainable funding levels for state infrastructure sectors that
