1 WHEREAS, The Texas House of Representatives is pleased to
2 recognize noted artist Hanh Tran of Houston on the occasion of the
3 launch of her current installation, the BIG TEXAS collection; and

4 WHEREAS, Hanh Tran's BIG TEXAS is a 50-piece collection of
5 her oil-on-canvas artworks; the colossal BIG TEXAS collection is
6 being presented in Austin on February 7 and will be installed at
7 Max's Underground at Max's Wine Dive, a private cellar and event
8 space, where it will remain for public viewing until June 8; and

9 WHEREAS, After the collection's exhibit in Austin, Hanh will
10 continue to exhibit the artwork on her first-ever statewide tour;
11 the collection embraces the uniqueness of the Lone Star State by
12 focusing on Texas nature, scenery, people, wildlife, and iconic
13 imagery; and

14 WHEREAS, Hanh Tran is a self-taught artist and a community
15 volunteer; she encourages others to face daily challenges by
16 incorporating art into their lives; each month, Hanh donates her
17 time by providing art therapy sessions and art lessons to the
18 children of the Texas-based charity the Sunshine Kids, and to the
19 patients of the North Cypress Medical Center's Cancer Division; and

20 WHEREAS, Hanh has recently established the Hanh Gallery Hero
21 program and annual award, which she has created to honor those who
22 lend their expertise to others and give back to the community
23 through their volunteerism; now, therefore, be it
