founding of New Hope Missionary Baptist Church in San Antonio; and

3 WHEREAS, Organized by the Reverend William Lampkin on the

4 banks of Menger Creek, the congregation was known as Israelite

5 Baptist Church before it adopted its present name in the 1920s;

6 since its inception, New Hope has also benefited from the dedicated

7 efforts of a number of other ministers, including the Reverends

8 Lindsay Johnson, Claude White, Thomas Harry Robinson, Houston

9 Duncan, S. L. Jackson, and Joshua Joubert, who leads the

10 congregation today; and

11 WHEREAS, Worship was initially held under a palm arbor, but

12 the continued growth of the membership necessitated several moves

13 to larger venues, culminating with the 1957 dedication of the

current church edifice at 1909 Martin Luther King Drive; over the

15 past half-century, remodeling has provided sufficient space for a

16 variety of commendable programs that focus on education, missions,

17 music, youth, and seniors, while additional ministries provide

18 opportunities for worship and fellowship for individuals in nursing

19 homes and in prisons; and

20 WHEREAS, Countless area residents have looked to New Hope

21 Missionary Baptist Church for inspiration and guidance through the

22 years, and it is a pleasure to join in honoring the church at this

23 special time in its rich history; now, therefore, be it
