- WHEREAS, Since the arrival of the railroads in the 1880s,

- 16 well, including farming and manufacturing; and
- 17 WHEREAS, Residents of Angelina County enjoy a wealth of
- 18 recreational opportunities; the county is home to the Angelina
- 19 National Forest, and the region's largest lake, the Sam Rayburn
- 20 Reservoir, offers superior bass fishing and an outlet for swimming
- 21 and boating; Lufkin, the county seat, features such popular
- 22 attractions as the Texas Forestry Museum, the Museum of East Texas,
- 23 and the Ellen Trout Zoo; and
