1 WHEREAS, For nearly a quarter-century, Texas Democratic
2 Women has encouraged participation in civic life; and

3 WHEREAS, Affiliated with the National Federation of
4 Democratic Women, Texas Democratic Women was founded in 1987 and is
5 headquartered in Austin; it promotes increased political
6 engagement by women and emphasizes the local, grassroots aspects of
7 politics; and

8 WHEREAS, The organization serves as a communication network
9 for existing Democratic women's organizations, and it unites Texans
10 from diverse backgrounds with respect to age, ethnicity,
11 occupation, geographical location, and interests; supplementing
12 its statewide training conferences and workshops, local chapters
13 offer a range of valuable programming, including informational
14 talks by guest speakers and discussions of local, state, and
15 national issues; and

16 WHEREAS, Providing opportunities to connect, exchange ideas,
17 and contribute to the public discourse, Texas Democratic Women
18 fosters political activism and volunteerism, and its members are
19 working to make a positive and lasting difference across the Lone
20 Star State; now, therefore, be it

21 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 82nd Texas
22 Legislature hereby commend Texas Democratic Women for 24 years of
23 service and extend to its officers and members sincere best wishes
24 for the future; and, be it further
