R E S O L U T I O N

1           WHEREAS, The Texas House of Representatives is pleased to  
2 join the members of the Rolling Plains Communities Partnership and  
3 citizens across the Lone Star State in celebrating February 22,  
4 2011, as Rolling Plains Day at the State Capitol; and

5           WHEREAS, The scenic Rolling Plains of North Central Texas is  
6 an area of approximately 28 million acres, much of which is covered  
7 with juniper woodlands and prairie midgrasses; the rugged Caprock  
8 Escarpment separates the Rolling Plains from the High Plains; and

9           WHEREAS, Four Texas rivers run through the soft prairie sands  
10 and clay soil of the region; the Canadian River, the Colorado River,  
11 the Concho River, and the Red River offer scenic beauty and many  
12 recreational opportunities; and

13           WHEREAS, The Rolling Plains Communities Partnership  
14 encourages rural counties to pool their resources in order to  
15 promote economic and community development in the area; the  
16 counties of Wheeler, Donley, Collingsworth, Briscoe, Hall,  
17 Childress, Motley, Cottle, Foard, and Hardeman have all benefited  
18 from the partnership's work; and

19           WHEREAS, The leadership and services provided by the Rolling  
20 Plains Communities Partnership have assisted numerous Texans, and  
21 this outstanding organization is truly deserving of recognition;  
22 now, therefore, be it
