14 back to her community as a board member of the Arlington Night
15 Shelter, president of the Arlington Home School Association, and

18 number of ministries; and

19 WHEREAS, Ann Ivey built a life that was rich in meaningful
20 endeavor, and although she is greatly missed, her legacy lives on in
