- 1 WHEREAS, The Texas Economic Development Council is observing
- 2 the 50th anniversary of its creation in 2011; and
- 3 WHEREAS, Originally known as the Texas Industrial
- 4 Development Council, the organization was founded in 1961 by a
- 5 group of individuals representing railroads, banks, utility
- 6 companies, chambers of commerce, and civic associations from all
- 7 across the state; preliminary meetings were held in Dallas,
- 8 Abilene, and Austin, and the first general membership meeting took
- 9 place in College Station, where the council's central
- 10 administrative office would be located at Texas A&M University for
- 11 nearly three decades; and
- 12 WHEREAS, The council was a driving force behind the
- 13 institution of the economic development sales tax in 1989 and has
- 14 supported the Texas Enterprise Fund, the Texas Emerging Technology
- 15 Fund, the Texas Economic Development Act, and the Skills
- 16 Development Fund; in 1991, the organization relocated to Austin,
- 17 and three years later the group adopted its present name; today, the
- 18 nearly 900 members of TEDC continue to work on issues of great
- 19 importance to the state, including investment, education, and
- 20 workforce development; and
- 21 WHEREAS, For half a century, TEDC has played an instrumental
- 22 role in spurring economic growth in the Lone Star State, and the
- 23 benefits of its accomplishments will positively affect Texans long
- 24 into the future; now, therefore, be it
