## RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, The year 2011 marks the 31st anniversary of the
founding of Young Conservatives of Texas; and

3 WHEREAS, A group of 177 students met in Austin at the Stephen 4 F. Austin Hotel on Texas Independence Day, March 2, 1980, to 5 establish Young Conservatives of Texas, an organization that would 6 provide students who believe in a conservative philosophy of 7 government the opportunity to participate effectively in the 8 political process; and

WHEREAS, YCT is dedicated to promoting its Statement of 9 Principles, including the beliefs that the Constitution was 10 11 instituted for the protection of God-given rights, that the American system of Federalism, describing limited government and 12 state sovereignty, serves to protect those rights, that economic 13 14 freedom and the free enterprise system are essential to liberty, and that the aim of American foreign policy should be the protection 15 16 of the freedom of the American people; and

17 WHEREAS, For more than three decades, YCT has maintained 18 chapters at the state's colleges and universities, which regularly 19 organize events representing a wide range of conservative thought; 20 and

21 WHEREAS, The organization has had great success in inspiring 22 young people in our state to become involved in politics, and its 23 alumni have gone on to serve in all levels of government and public 24 policy, including the Texas Legislature and the United States
