1 WHEREAS, Members of Leadership Lewisville are visiting the
2 State Capitol on February 22, 2011, to gain further insight into the
3 workings of state government; and

4 WHEREAS, The Leadership Lewisville program is sponsored by
5 the Lewisville Area Chamber of Commerce; the course was created in
6 1986 to identify, educate, develop, and motivate future civic
7 leaders by providing them with a means to better understand the
8 challenges and opportunities facing the community; and

9 WHEREAS, All residents of the greater Lewisville area are
10 eligible to apply for the program; over the course of nine months,
11 participants study the functions and procedures of their city,
12 county, and state, for instance by attending school board and city
13 council meetings, and they learn about businesses and economic
14 factors and discover ways that they can make the area a better place

17 citizenry and to develop new leaders, this worthwhile program is
18 helping to build a bright future for Lewisville, which in turn
19 benefits all citizens of the Lone Star State; now, therefore, be it
