16 the craft in 2003, and she is also a talented cornet player who has
17 performed with the Alpine Orchestra; moreover, she belongs to the
18 Alpine Community Band and the Hungry 5 Oompah Band; and

19 WHEREAS, Ms. Zukowski enjoyed 34 years of marriage with her
20 husband, John, who passed away in 2008, and she takes great pride in
21 their son, Geoff, and three grandchildren, Kimber, Bobby, and
22 Johnny; and

23 WHEREAS, Sue Zukowski benefited the members of the Sul Ross
24 community with her dedication and professionalism, and she may

1 indeed reflect with pride on a career well spent as she embarks on
2 the next exciting chapter of her life; now, therefore, be it

4 Legislature hereby congratulate Sue Zukowski on her retirement from
