

R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, Bruce D. Glasscock was appointed city manager of
2 Plano by the Plano City Council on February 17, 2011; and

3 WHEREAS, A veteran of the U.S. Air Force, Mr. Glasscock
4 served as chief of police in Fort Collins, Colorado, before being
5 named chief of police in Plano in 1990; under his leadership, the
6 department was accredited by the Commission on Accreditation for
7 Law Enforcement Agencies, which it maintains today; and

8 WHEREAS, In 1998, while continuing to oversee the police
9 department, Mr. Glasscock was appointed assistant city manager,
10 and he served concurrently in those roles until 2001, when he
11 stepped down as chief of police; that same year, he accepted the
12 post of deputy city manager; his civic responsibilities have
13 included coordinating the City Council Strategic Plan and the City
14 Council Community Outreach programs, as well as federal and state
15 legislative activities, and he has supervised such key departments
16 as police, fire, emergency management, and health services; and

17 WHEREAS, Mr. Glasscock holds a bachelor's degree in criminal
18 justice management from Metropolitan State College of Denver and a
19 master's degree in public administration from the University of
20 Colorado at Denver; he is a former president of the International
21 Association of Chiefs of Police and has contributed greatly to his
22 community as a board member and past president of the Children's
23 Advocacy Center of Collin County and as an advisory board member of
24 the Rape Crisis Center of Collin County; moreover, he has served as

1 a board member of the Texas Municipal League and Special Olympics
2 Texas; and

3 WHEREAS, For more than two decades, Bruce Glasscock has
4 diligently worked in behalf of the citizens of Plano, and his
5 experience, vision, and commitment to excellence are sure to
6 continue to improve their quality of life; now, therefore, be it

7 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 82nd Texas
8 Legislature hereby congratulate Bruce D. Glasscock on his
9 appointment as Plano city manager and extend to him sincere best
10 wishes for continued success and happiness; and, be it further

11 RESOLVED, That an official copy of this resolution be

13 Texas House of Representatives.
