WHEREAS, Officer Holder was predeceased by his first wife, Robin Johnson Holder; fortunate to find love a second time, he married Annemarie Rankin on June 4, 1994; this devoted husband was also a caring father to his two children, Hilary and Kyler, and he took great delight in his twin granddaughters, Reese and Rylee; and WHEREAS, Throughout his career, Rodney Holder upheld the
