RESOLUTION

- 1 WHEREAS, The Allen Independent School District has provided
- 2 generations of young Texans with a quality education, and local
- 3 residents are celebrating the district's 100th anniversary in 2011;
- 4 and
- 5 WHEREAS, Citizens of Allen voted in 1910 to convert its
- 6 common school district, which had been established in 1883, to an
- 7 independent school district; a bond election funded construction of
- 8 a two-story brick building with six rooms and an auditorium, which
- 9 remained the main classroom facility for five decades; and
- 10 WHEREAS, The district faced numerous challenges early in its
- 11 history, including shrinking enrollment, inadequate facilities,
- 12 and a shortage of teachers and courses; in the 1940s, Allen ISD
- 13 trustees began actively recruiting educators, and concerned
- 14 citizens helped to keep them in the district by providing them with
- 15 housing and paying their salaries through PTA donations; and
- 16 WHEREAS, During the 1950s, voters supported two bond
- 17 elections by wide margins, and in 1959, the district opened Allen
- 18 High School; enrollments began to rise in the following decade, and
- 19 finally exceeded 500 for the first time in the 1968-69 school year;
- 20 Rountree Elementary School opened as the district's first
- 21 elementary school in 1974; and
- 22 WHEREAS, The 1980s brought considerable growth as farmland
- 23 yielded to new subdivisions, and the student population of 3,700 in
- 24 1986 doubled by 1993; expansion continued apace during the 1990s as

- 1 the district built a number of new schools, including the
- 2 state-of-the-art Allen High School in 2000; and
- WHEREAS, Today, Allen ISD serves some 19,000 students on 22
- 4 campuses; it earned an Exemplary rating from the Texas Education
- 5 Agency in 2010, with 18 individual campuses rated Exemplary and two
- 6 rated Recognized; in addition to offering instruction in several
- 7 foreign languages and an international baccalaureate program, the
- 8 district sponsors a broad range of vocational courses; moreover, it
- 9 enjoys strong community support for its athletics, and a bond
- 10 election funded construction of a \$59.6 million football stadium
- 11 that seats 18,000 fans; and
- 12 WHEREAS, The Allen Independent School District has changed
- 13 dramatically over the course of the past century, but it has not
- 14 wavered in its commitment to providing high-quality educational
- 15 opportunities to area students, and its rich tradition remains a
- 16 tremendous source of pride for the surrounding community; now,
- 17 therefore, be it
- 18 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 82nd Texas
- 19 Legislature hereby commemorate the centennial celebration of the
- 20 Allen Independent School District and extend to all those
- 21 associated with the district sincere best wishes for continued
- 22 success; and, be it further
- 23 RESOLVED, That an official copy of this resolution be
- 24 prepared for the district as an expression of high regard by the
- 25 Texas House of Representatives.
