- 7 Medical Center with its Legacy Award, an accolade presented to
- 8 physicians who embody the highest values of the medical profession;

- 11 and to building a strong medical presence in Angleton, Dr. Weiner
- 12 retired in September 2007; today he enjoys spending time with his
- 13 wife Gebe, his three children, and his two grandchildren; and
- WHEREAS, Dr. Benjamin Weiner has garnered the lasting respect
- 15 and admiration of his fellow doctors, his patients, the employees
- 16 of Angleton Danbury Medical Center, and people from throughout the
