1 WHEREAS, Country music singer Mark Chesnutt is performing in
2 Austin on February 28, 2011, in conjunction with Golden Triangle
3 Days at the State Capitol, where residents from that area are
4 gathering to work together for the good of their region and the
5 State of Texas; and

6 WHEREAS, A fitting performer for this special occasion, Mark
7 Chesnutt was born and raised in Beaumont; he remained a Texas
8 resident even after attracting the attention of Nashville record
9 companies and being signed to a major label in 1989; and

10 WHEREAS, Over the course of the next few years, Mr. Chesnutt
11 became a major country star; the winner of the Country Music
12 Association Horizon Award in 1993, he has had four platinum albums
13 in his career and eight number one singles; his string of hits
14 includes "Brother Jukebox," "Blame It On Texas," "Almost Goodbye,"
15 and "I Don't Want To Miss A Thing," and he is known as one of the
16 industry's hardest working concert performers; and

18 community where he first learned to make music, Mark Chesnutt
