- 1 WHEREAS, In every region of the State of Texas, grandparents
- 2 can be found who are raising their grandchildren, striving to
- 3 ensure that these young people are safe, loved, and well cared for
- 4 and able to become happy and productive adults; and
- 5 WHEREAS, According to data compiled by a consortium that
- 6 includes the AARP Foundation, Casey Family Programs, the Children's
- 7 Defense Fund, and others, more than seven percent of all children in
- 8 Texas live in households headed by grandparents, and more than a
- 9 quarter of a million Texans report that they are responsible for
- 10 grandchildren who are residing with them; and
- 11 WHEREAS, Nearly a third of these grandparents live in a
- 12 household that does not include the children's parents; moreover,
- 13 about three-quarters of these caregivers are under the age of 60,
- 14 and, sadly, more than one in five live in poverty; and
- 15 WHEREAS, Increasingly, grandparents are asked to take
- 16 parental responsibility for their grandchildren, creating unique
- 17 family structures with a range of special needs; despite the
- 18 sometimes challenging circumstances they face, these individuals
- 19 selflessly provide vital care to their loved ones that is truly
- 20 deserving of special recognition; now, therefore, be it
- 21 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 82nd Texas
- 22 Legislature hereby commend Texas grandparents who are raising their
- 23 grandchildren and honor them for the valuable role they play in
- 24 preparing our state's young people for the future.
