- 1 WHEREAS, The courageous Americans who fought for this country 2 during the critical years of World War II are deserving of the highest respect, and Jack Walker was among those who endured the 3 grim dangers of war to help preserve his nation's freedom and 4 5 prosperity; and WHEREAS, Born on July 1, 1913, Mr. Walker grew up in Longview 6 7 and enlisted in the United States Army in 1942, becoming a sergeant in the Military Police Corps; his unit saw action in France during 8 the Normandy campaign in the summer of 1944, and while carrying out 9
- his duties there, he suffered serious injury in an explosion; and 10 11 WHEREAS, Sergeant Walker received several citations and 12 decorations for his service in uniform, including the European-African-Middle Eastern 13 Campaign Medal, the 14 Asiatic-Pacific Campaign Medal, the Army Good Conduct Medal, and
- the World War II Victory Medal; and 15 WHEREAS, After the war, Mr. Walker attended cooking school in 16 Dallas; he became a kitchen manager at Southern Methodist 17 University and worked for the school for 51 years before retiring; 18 this beloved husband and father passed away on June 4, 2004, and his 19 20 loss was felt deeply by his family and friends; and
- 21 WHEREAS, One of the exceptional Americans whose courage and determination helped their nation to emerge triumphant from the 22 23 dark days of a world war, Jack Walker went on to enjoy a rewarding and purposeful life; his many admirable achievements are a source 24
