1           WHEREAS, For nearly 50 years, Mark Clanton of San Antonio has  
2 dedicated himself to serving others, first through his three  
3 decades in the United States Air Force and then through his work as  
4 a public school teacher; and

5           WHEREAS, Mr. Clanton entered the air force in the mid-1960s  
6 and served at bases throughout the country as well as in Japan; in  
7 1973, he took a teaching post at the U.S. Air Force Academy in  
8 Colorado Springs, Colorado, remaining on the faculty there until  
9 1977; in all, he spent more than two decades as a professional  
10 military educator; and

11           WHEREAS, In 1994, Mr. Clanton completed his 30-year career  
12 with the air force; having already earned a bachelor's degree in  
13 business from Texas Lutheran University, he undertook graduate  
14 studies at Southwest Texas State University and received a master's  
15 degree in education in 1996; and

16           WHEREAS, Certified in special education, Mr. Clanton has  
17 taught at Ed White Middle School in San Antonio's North East  
18 Independent School District for the past 17 years; and

19           WHEREAS, Mark Clanton has contributed to his fellow citizens  
20 through a lifetime of purposeful endeavor, and he has set an  
21 inspiring example of leadership, integrity, and commitment to  
22 excellence; now, therefore, be it
