RESOLUTION

1 WHEREAS, Taking on the nation's growing budget crisis, United 2 States senator Rand Paul has introduced the Cut Federal Spending Act of 2011, a bold proposal to slash the cost of government by \$500 3 billion; and 4 5 WHEREAS. According to Congressional Budget Office projections, the federal budget will show a deficit of close to \$1.5 6 trillion in 2011 if current laws remain unchanged; this alarming 7 figure represents 9.8 percent of gross domestic product; the 8 9 country ran similar deficits in the past two years, with deficits of \$1.4 trillion and \$1.3 trillion in 2009 and 2010, respectively; and 10 11 WHEREAS, The Cut Federal Spending Act would roll back federal 12 expenditures to 2008 levels by ending wasteful programs and those that are beyond the constitutional role of the federal government, 13 14 such as education and housing; the measure would effectively eliminate nearly 40 percent of the projected deficit; and 15 WHEREAS, Annual deficits of more than \$1 trillion imperil the 16 health of our already struggling economy; the \$500 billion 17 reduction achieved through the Cut Federal Spending Act would 18 reduce the amount of interest that the U.S. government owes to 19 20 foreign holders of its debt and eventually lessen the tax burden on 21 individual citizens; moreover, it would allow more money to remain in local coffers, enabling states, counties, municipalities, and 22 23 school districts to better manage their own budget challenges; now, 24 therefore, be it
