1 WHEREAS, The Texas House of Representatives joins the

4 WHEREAS, King's Fort was established by William P. King and
5 40 pioneers in 1840; Kaufman County was created in 1848, and three
6 years later King's Fort was selected as its county seat and renamed
7 Kaufman, in honor of David Spangler Kaufman, a member of the Texas
8 Legislature and the United States Congress; and

9 WHEREAS, Kaufman County is one of the fastest growing
10 counties in the state and has several of the top rated public school
11 districts in North Texas; and

12 WHEREAS, Kaufman County is home to Southwestern Christian
13 College, Trinity Valley Community College, and TVCC Health Sciences
14 Center, as well as historical and cultural attractions such as the
15 No. 1 British Flying Training School Museum, the Kaufman County
16 Poor Farm, and the Terrell Heritage Society Museum; and

19 indeed a privilege to pay tribute to this county and its citizens at
