1 WHEREAS, The members of First Shiloh Missionary Baptist
2 Church in Houston are celebrating the 120th anniversary of their
3 church's founding in March 2011; and

4 WHEREAS, First Shiloh Missionary Baptist was organized in
5 1891 by families who resettled in Houston following a devastating
6 flood of the Red River in Shreveport, Louisiana; the church
7 constructed its first building at the turn of the century, and in
8 1955 members entered a new two-story brick structure that continues
9 to house services today; and

10 WHEREAS, Through the years, First Shiloh Missionary Baptist
11 has benefited from the able guidance of many dedicated leaders, and
12 that tradition of service continues under the direction of the
13 current pastor, the Reverend John E. Fields; and

14 WHEREAS, United by their shared faith and strong traditions,
15 the men and women of this notable house of worship support a variety
16 of commendable programs that offer fellowship as well as help to
17 those in need, including Operation Outreach and the Junior Church;

19 WHEREAS, First Shiloh Missionary Baptist has long served as a

22 its members, both past and present; now, therefore, be it
